- Higher English proficiency scores enhance readiness for our English-medium environment.

Applicants must arrange their registration and completion of the test online.

What is the Duolingo English Test?

The Duolingo English Test is an online proficiency test assessing reading, writing, speaking, and listening skills. It provides an efficient alternative to traditional exams and is recognised by institutions globally, including Soka International School Malaysia.

Duolingo English Test Overview

The test consists of two main sections:

Adaptive Test	Writing & Speaking Samples
45 minutes	10 minutes
Dynamically adjusts question difficulty based on answers.	Assesses fluency and xpressive ability through selected prompts.

Test Components:

Reading Comprehension	Answer questions about short texts.
Listening Comprehension	Respond to audio clips.
Speaking	Describe images and answer prompts.
Writing	Write responses on various topics.

Duolingo English Test Day Requirements

To take the test, You MUST have:



A valid passport, driver's license, or government-issued ID.



A computer with a front-facing camera, microphone, and speakers.



A fully charged phone as a secondary camera. (a tablet is also acceptable)



A reliable internet connection.



A quiet, private, and well-lit room.



60 minutes of uninterrupted time.

Which IDs are accepted for the Duolingo English Test?



All IDs must be government-issued and meet the following criteria:

- (i) Full legal name
- (ii) Photo of your face
- (iii) Country of Issuance
- (iv) Full date of birth
- (v) Valid expiration date



You must present your physical ID. Photocopies and digital images are not accepted.

For Malaysian test takers, MyKid cards are NOT acceptable as it does not contain a photo of your face. In that case, please use a passport.

Important Reminders for Test Day



If you break any of the rules of the Duolingo English Test, Duolingo reserves the right to not certify your test results, or to invalidate any previously certified results, without providing a refund. Depending on the extent of the violation, you may also be permanently banned from taking the Duolingo English Test again.

Test Security Policy:

Maintaining the integrity of the Duolingo English Test is essential to ensuring a fair admissions process. Any breach of test security—such as misconduct, use of unauthorised aids, or impersonation—will result in immediate disqualification.

Applicants permanently banned by the test provider will not be considered for admission.

Important Test Rules:

Read <u>all of the rules</u> for test-taking carefully so that your test will be secure and valid. The test will also remind you of the rules right before you start.

Selection of Primary Test Rules:



Take the test alone in a quiet room. Do not let anyone be in the room with you.



Place non-required devices (phones, tablets, smartwatches, etc.) in another room.



Close all other browsers (Chrome, Microsoft Edge, etc), programmes and applications, including those running in the background.



Do not take notes.



Do not interact with anyone or leave the test area.



Remove writing materials, paper, and books from your test area.



Set your phone (secondary camera) to "Do Not Disturb" mode.



Keep your face (ears, eyes, and mouth) visible and uncovered.



Do not wear headphones or earbuds.



Keep your eyes on the screen while speaking.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

1. Can my child retake the Duolingo English Test?

Yes. A three-day waiting period is required between attempts. Each attempt requires a separate payment unless a test bundle is used.

2. How long are Duolingo English Test results valid?

Results are valid for two years.

3. What if technical issues arise during the test?

Contact Duolingo's support team via the orange HELP button on your test account. Live chat support is available from Monday 00:00 a.m. UTC to Saturday 00:00 a.m. UTC.
