Applicants must arrange their registration and completion of the test online.

What is the Duolingo English Test?

The Duolingo English Test is an online proficiency test assessing reading, writing, speaking, and listening skills. It provides an efficient alternative to traditional exams and is recognised by institutions globally, including Soka International School Malaysia.

The test consists of two main sections:

Adaptive Test	Writing & Speaking Samples	
45 minutes	10 minutes	
Dynamically adjusts question difficulty based on answers.	Assesses fluency and expressive ability through selected prompts.	

Test Components:

Reading Comprehension	Answer questions about short texts.	
Listening Comprehension	Respond to audio clips.	
Speaking	Describe images and answer prompts.	
Writing	Write responses on various topics.

☑ PRIVATE & QUIET ROOM FOR THE TEST

• Make sure the room is bright and lit.

 No one should enter or be in the room with you.

Note: You must be **alone** in the room when taking the test.



☑ LEARN HOW TO SET UP YOUR PHONE AS A SECONDARY CAMERA

- On the test day, start the Duolingo English Test and scan the QRCode given.
- Set your phone to the "Do not Disturb" mode.
- Set up the phone next to your laptop.



 Check the phone camera. Make sure your entire laptop is visible and that your keyboard and computer screen are fully visible.

Examples of the rules:

- 1. Do not take the test at public areas such as your dining room or living room.
- 2. Remove writing materials, paper, and books from your test area.
- 3. Place non-required devices (phones, smartwatches, tablets etc.) in another room.
- 4. Close all other browsers (Chrome, Microsoft Edge, etc), programmes and applications, including those running in the background on your laptop.
- 5. Keep your face (ears, eyes, and mouth) visible and uncovered.
- 6. Do not take notes.
- 7. Do not interact with anyone or leave the test area.
- 8. Keep your eyes on the screen while speaking.

If you break any of the rules of the Duolingo English Test, Duolingo reserves the right to not certify your test results, or to invalidate any previously certified results, without providing a refund. Depending on the extent of the violation, you may also be permanently banned from taking the Duolingo English Test again.

Test Security Policy:

Maintaining the integrity of the Duolingo English Test is essential to ensuring a fair admissions process. Any breach of test security—such as misconduct, use of unauthorised aids, or impersonation—will result in immediate disqualification.

Applicants permanently banned by the test provider will not be considered for admission.

Important Test Rules:

Read <u>all of the rules</u> for test-taking carefully so that your test will be secure and valid. The test will also remind you of the rules right before you start.

Selection of Primary Test Rules:



Take the test alone in a quiet room. Do not let anyone be in the room with you.



Place non-required devices (phones, tablets, smartwatches, etc.) in another room.



Close all other windows and programs, including any that are running in the background.



Do not take notes.



Do not interact with anyone or leave the test area.



Remove writing materials, paper, and books from your test area.



Set your phone (secondary camera) to "Do Not Disturb" mode.



Keep your face (ears, eyes, and mouth) visible and uncovered.



Do not wear headphones or earbuds.



Keep your eyes on the screen while speaking.
